

The Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Sustainable Coastal and Marine Fisheries Project, and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for Shrimp cluster mobilization including farmer database and ID cards, and integrated e-traceability system design and deployment, and related business plan development.
2. The Department of Fisheries represented by the Project Director of Sustainable Coastal and Marine Fisheries Project now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for Shrimp cluster mobilization including farmer database and ID cards, and integrated e-traceability system design and deployment, and related business plan development.
3. Bidding will be conducted through **international competitive procurement** using a Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers, July 2016 revised November 2017" ("Procurement Regulations"), and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.
4. Interested eligible Bidders may obtain further information from the Office of the Project Director, Sustainable Coastal and Marine Fisheries Project, Department of Fisheries, Matshya Bhaban, Ramna, Dhaka and inspect the bidding document during office hours i.e., 09:00 to 17:00 hours (Local time-GMT+06:00Hours) before the deadline for bid submission at the address given below. The bidding document is also available in the **Notice** board of the websites of Department of Fisheries (www.fisheries.gov.bd) and scmfp.fisheries.gov.bd, which can be downloaded for viewing/inspection purpose only but not for use in the preparation and submission of bids.
5. A complete set of the bidding documents in English may be purchased by prospective bidders upon (i) submission of a written application letter which may be sent through email from the bidder's official email address to the Employer's official email address specified below and (ii) payment of a nonrefundable fee which includes courier services cost for delivery of the bidding documents to the bidder. The fee for bidding documents requested by bidders for delivery outside Bangladesh is USD 100.00 or BDT 8500.00. The fee for bidding documents requested by bidders for delivery within Bangladesh is BDT 4500.00. The method of payment of the fee is through electronic wire transfer by the bidder to the Employer's bank account specified below. A copy of the electronic wire transmission confirmation must be attached, as evidence of payment, with the bidder's application letter. Within 3 (three) working days of receipt by the Employer of the bidder's email with the



application letter and copy of the electronic wire transmission confirmation, the Employer will dispatch a complete set of the bidding documents to the bidder through courier service and also inform the bidder through email of the courier service order/tracking number. The Employer shall not be responsible or liable for any delay or failure of delivery of the bidding documents by the courier service to the bidder.

6. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before 15:00 Hours (Local time- GMT+06:00Hours), 23 May 2021. Electronic Bidding will not be permitted. Late Bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened on 15:30 Hours (Local time- GMT+06:00Hours), 23 May 2021. In view of constraints on account of COVID-19 pandemic for the Bidders to attend the Bid opening physically, the Bid opening will be conducted virtually through live video conference, for which electronic connection link will be sent by the *Employer* at least seven (7) calendar days prior to the date of opening through e-mail to all the potential Bidders who obtained/acquired the Bidding Document and who may choose to attend through video conference.
7. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security of USD 35000.00 or an equivalent amount in a freely convertible currency as per the requirements detailed in the bidding documents.
8. A pre-bid meeting will be held on 15:00 Hours (Local time- GMT+06:00Hours), 12 April 2021 at the address given below. Interested bidders are requested to attend the meeting. In view of constraints on account of COVID-19 pandemic, the pre-bid meeting will be conducted virtually through live video conference, for which electronic connection link will be sent by the Employer at least seven (7) calendar days prior to the date of pre-bid meeting through e-mail to all the potential Bidders who obtained/acquired the Bidding Document and who may choose to attend through video conference.
