

Syed Md. Alamgir Director General Department of Fisheries, Bangladesh

Syed Md. Alamgir took over the post of Director General of Department of Fisheries on December 30, 2023. Prior to joining this post, he served as the Principal Scientific Officer (Planning and Survey) of the Department of Fisheries. Mr. Alamgir was born in a noble Muslim family in Sadar upazila under Brahmanbaria district. He completed his secondary in 1981 from Annada Government High School, Brahmanbaria with 1st division and higher secondary in 1983 from district in 1981 from Comilla Victoria Government College. Later, he graduated from Bangladesh Agricultural University, Mymensingh with a bachelor's degree in fisheries in 1987 and an MSc degree in fisheries technology in 1988 from the same university. During his university life, he was a resident student of Shaheed Shamsul Haque Hall.

Syed Md. Alamgir was recruited and joined the BCS (Fisheries) cadre in 1993 with 1st rank in the BCS (Fisheries) cadre in the 11th BCS examination. He served as Upazila Fisheries Officer, Deputy Project Director, District Fisheries Officer, Divisional Deputy Director, Deputy Director (Administration), Principal Scientific Officer (Planning and Survey) and Director (Inland) of Department of Fisheries.

He has participated in various trainings in the country and also in Thailand, Germany and UK. Mr. Alamgir has played a notable role as a departmental trainer in the training management, module formulation of the department. He was awarded Gold Medal as National Fisheries Award by Hon'ble Prime Minister in the year 2019 and National Integrity Award in the last financial year 2022-23.
