The Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the **Sustainable Coastal and Marine Fisheries Project**, and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for Supply and Installation of VMS including MTUs (marine transmission unit) and relevant Hardware and Software. For this contract, the Borrower shall process the payments using the Direct Payment disbursement method, as defined in the World Bank's Disbursement Guidelines for Investment Project Financing, except for those payments, which the contract provides to be made through letter of credit.
2. The Department of Fisheries now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for related VMS software leasing for 3 years, Supply of 100 MTUs (marine transmission unit), providing training on VMS of 40.00 nos officials and supply of office hardware.
3. Bidding will be conducted through international competitive procurement using a Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers, July 2016 revised November 2017" ("Procurement Regulations"), and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.
4. Interested eligible Bidders may obtain further information from Office of Project Director, Sustainable Coastal and Marine Fisheries Project, Department of Fisheries, Matshya Bhaban, Dhaka and inspect the bidding document during office hours i.e. 09:00 to 17:00 hours (Local time- GMT+06:00Hours) before the submission date at the address given below.
5. The bidding document in English may be purchased by interested Bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee of USD 50.00 (fifty US dollar only). The method of payment will be direct deposit or payment order in favour of the Project Director, Sustainable Coastal and Marine Fisheries Project. The document will be sent by courier or airmail or e-mail. The cost of airmail or courier shall be borne by the bidder.
6. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before 11:00Hours (Local time- GMT+06:00Hours), 30<sup>th</sup> January, 2020. Electronic Bidding will not be permitted. Late Bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders' designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend at the address below on 11:30 Hours (Local time- GMT+06:00Hours), 30<sup>th</sup> January, 2020.
7. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security of USD 15000.00 (US Dollar fifteen thousand only) or equivalent in other acceptable currency.
8. Attention is drawn to the Procurement Regulations requiring the Borrower to disclose information on the successful bidder's beneficial ownership, as part of the Contract Award Notice, using the Beneficial Ownership Disclosure Form as included in the bidding document.
